



SPECIAL CARE FOR YOUR SHEET-FOAM MASCOT

WARNING: Read and follow instructions carefully. Our warranty only covers clean, un-abused costumes. Failure to follow these care instructions may void warranty.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. This Custom Mascot has a specially airbrushed coat using a unique ink system specially formulated for fabric. You cannot wash the facial portions of the character. Portions of the costume with no airbrushing (like the sleeves or pants) may be machine washed in a delicate cycle using Woolite or comparable brand.**
- 2. Clean using an upholstery or carpet cleaner by hand, avoiding the air-brushed areas. Allow to drip dry and never store while damp. Do not place in a dryer and do not dry-clean.**
- 3. Keep the Sheet-Foam costume suspended on a stand or on a shelf. Store in a well ventilated area away from excessive temperatures and humidity. Do not store in a box or case, as this may crush the facial features.**
- 4. Brush the fur regularly, and keep clean with a soft sponge and mild detergent. You may use upholstery cleaner on fur-covered areas only, avoiding airbrushed areas. A spray disinfectant may be used on the inside of the costume to eliminate unpleasant odors.**
- 5. Mascot feet should be kept clean with an upholstery or rug cleaner and completely dried before storing in a plastic bag. A disinfectant may also be used for the feet.**
- 6. Never wear the costume in the presence of fire or while smoking. Do not wear the costume while driving or operating dangerous equipment.**
- 7. Minor repairs can be performed easily and will keep your costume looking like new. If you find an area that needs attention, use a little hot glue, contact cement, or a needle & thread. This will prevent little problems from becoming big ones.**
- 8. Remember the costume will last longer if it is kept clean and not abused. We firmly believe that you have purchased the finest mascot produced in the U.S. and will be able to enjoy it for a long, long time, so please take care of it. Thank You!**
